

Firearms Safety Rules

- 1. <u>Muzzle Management:</u> ALWAYS keep your muzzle pointed in a safe direction.
- 2. <u>Trigger Finger Discipline:</u> ALWAYS keep your finger off the trigger until you are on target and ready to fire. Trigger finger should always rest high on the weapons frame in line with the barrel. If your weapon is equipped with a mechanical safety, you WILL you the safety at all times.
- 3. Know the status of your firearm(s) at all times. Failure to comply is NOT an option.
- 4. Identify your target, what's around it and beyond. YOU are responsible for the impact of EVERY round.
- 5. Ear protection and protective glasses are required to be worn at all times while firing.
- 6. When clearing your weapon, ensure the muzzle in pointed in a safe direction, drop the magazine, lock the slide to the rear, then **Visually and Physically** inspect to ensure both the chamber and weapon is clear.
- 7. Follow all additional guidance provided by instructors and range staff.
- 8. You are expected to use good judgment, and to refrain from attempting any exercise, which you may not be able to preform safely, based on your ability, equipment, prior training, or physical condition.
- 9. Remember: Everyone is a safety. Call "Cease Fire" if you observe any unsafe act.

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
